## SECTION 2 APPEALS

Any member of the Nation whose name has been removed from the official List of Registered Voters or whose name has been omitted in error, or whose name, for other reasons, has not been added to such list by action of a district council after registering in accordance with section 1 above, may appeal to the Tohono O’odham Council for listing at least fifteen (15) days prior to the general, primary or special election. The Tohono O’odham Council shall, if necessary, call a special meeting to decide such appeals. If the Council should decide that the appellant is a qualified voter, it shall order that the appellant’s name be placed on the list. The decision of the Council shall be final.
