NOTICE OF FINAL RULE

Pursuant to Article II, Section 2 (A) of the Election Ordinance, ORD 03-86, authorizing the Election Board to "formulate, adopt, amend and rescind rules, regulations, guidelines and forms reasonably necessary to carry out the provisions" of the Election Ordinance, the Election Board hereby adopts the following rule, effective December 6, 2012.

- 1) A current registered voter wishing to transfer his or her voter registration from one district or community to another shall complete a Voter Transfer Form approved by the Election Board for such purpose and shall file such form with the Election Office.
- 2) Upon receipt of a completed Voter Transfer Form, the Election Office shall confirm that the voter submitting such form is currently registered to vote in the district designated by the voter, and if confirmed, shall forward a copy of the completed Voter Transfer Form to the district or community to which the voter is requesting transfer.
- 3) The affected District shall notify the Election Board by resolution approving or denying the Voter Transfer request.
- 4) Once the District action has been provided to and reviewed by the Election Board, the Election Office staff shall note the transfer in the Official List of Registered Voters.
